

BENEFITS OF WORKPLACE CHARGING

There are multiple benefits to offering smart EV charging at your workplace. With an EV charging network, you can control access to your stations in order to prioritize them as an employee amenity. Create and manage your network of charging stations, create custom membership groups, and set up access controls so public users cannot charge without permission.

You can also offer customized pricing for your drivers. Some companies with public parking choose to assign tiered pricing, so public users pay a fee, while employees charge their vehicles for free. Your human resources department can add free car charging as part of your company's benefits package!

With a smart network, your employees can use a mobile app to see which charging stations are available. You can even turn on a wait-list feature that will notify drivers the moment a charging station becomes available. The ability to view live station status helps your employees plan their charging sessions around meetings and scheduled breaks, so it's easier to charge at work.

Finally, smart networked charging stations provide you, the station owner, with reports about the success of your program. Download reports with metrics such as usage, CO2 offset, energy cost, and revenue per station or per location. You can easily include your charging stations in your company's year-end reports, which can help you decide when it's time to add more charging stations to your locations!
